Admissions Policy for Years 11 and 12 (Sekundarstufe 2)

1. Programmes in Years 11 and 12

1.1 GIB Diploma Programme

All students who attend Deutsche Schule Hurghada in Years 11 and 12 must enter the GIB Diploma Programme. They attend all subjects (one subject from each of the six subject groups plus CAS and TOK) which are required by the DP and work according to the School Policies for these years. Further, they receive sports or arts lessons for two lessons each week.

1.2 Egyptian Programme

Only the **students who are enrolled in the Egyptian Programme** need to take part in the *additional* Egyptian subjects for year 11 and 12. These students receive circa five lessons on top each week in both Years 11 and 12. These lessons are based on the national curriculum for Years 11 and 12 and include Egyptian language and literature, Civics and Religious Education. These students must also take part in the official exams scheduled by the Egyptian State. The amount of tests for the Egyptian curriculum can be seen in the document "assessment policy".

All other students are allowed to join these classes, but the norm is that these students only concentrate on the IB DP.

2. Admissions

2.1 Admissions for Students who visited Year 10 at Deutsche Schule Hurghada:

Students have to pass the **central written exams for *Gymnasien*** (*Schriftliche Prüfung zum Eintritt in die Qualifikationsphase der gymnasialen Oberstufe und zentrale Klassenarbeit an deutschen Schulen im Ausland*) by the German Kultusministerkonferenz in German, English and Mathematics and an oral exam in one subject in year 10 to be admitted to the DP.

If students took part in the **central exams for *Realschulen***, the students need to pass these exams. Additionally they and their parent(s) must have a meeting with the IB Coordinator, in which all subject marks are looked at and the students demonstrate their motivation to fulfil the requirements of the IB DP. The IB Coordinator then admits the student to Year 11 or gives recommendations for alternative future schooling of the pupil (e.g. repeating Year 10).

2.2 Admissions for students who change to the Deutsche Schule Hurghada after year 10 (and before year 11):

These students need to fulfil two requirements:

1. Provide a document, that they are admitted to a German school year 11 (written exams in year 10 or equivalent to the central written exams) *or* provide a document that they are admitted to an international school year 11.

2. Demonstrate in a talk with the IB coordinator that their command of English and German is sufficient to participate in classes at Deutsche Schule Hurghada and that they are motivated to fulfil all the requirements of the IB DP.

The IB Coordinator then decides if the students can be admitted to Year 11.

Alternatively these students can do year 10 at Deutsche Schule Hurghada and take part in the central written exams mentioned above.
